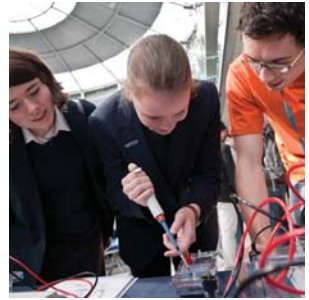

## Celebrating King Street Community Voices

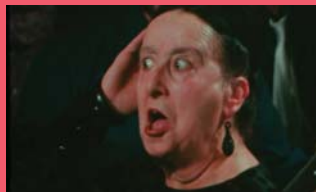
